Some relevant Bible verses from the King James Bible which George Herbert would have been familiar with. In brackets is a modern paraphrase.

Lay up for yourselves **treasures** in heaven.

Matthew 6:20

(Valuing relationship with God over collecting treasures on earth)



A good name is rather to be chosen than great **riches**.

Proverbs 22:1

(A good reputation is better than wealth)

And now abideth **faith, hope, charity**, these three; but the greatest of these is charity. (1 Corinthians 13:13)

(Faith, hope and love are the top three virtues but love is the greatest of all)

Note: Charity is an old word for love but it has changed its meaning over 400 years.

Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you **rest**. . . . Matthew 11:28-29

(I will give rest deep down)



A promise . . . of entering into his (God's) **rest**.

Hebrews 4:1

(A promise of rest with God)

. . . let us **run** with patience the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus . . . Hebrews 12:1-2

(Run the race of life with patience, keeping your eyes on Jesus)

. . . the dead shall be **raised** . . . 1 Corinthians 15:52

(After death, people will rise again to new life)
